1. **Fees are due at time of registration.** Pay by Credit Card online or Make check payable to Holy Family Athletics.
2. Submit a copy of your child's birth certificate if you not have done so in a previous year.
3. Complete the physical form (one per child) and have it signed by your family physician dated 6/1/18 or later. This registration form will be active with CYO for all sports between 6/1/18-5/31/19. **All athletes must have this form completed PRIOR to the start of his/her first practice. NO ATHLETE WILL BE PERMITTED TO PLAY WITHOUT A COMPLETED CYO REGISTRATION FORM!**
